

Your New Essix Retainer

Congratulations on the removal of your braces! To keep your smile beautiful, we're providing you with a set of custom-fit clear retainers to wear. It is *very* important that you wear these as directed by Dr. Zhu!

Here are some tips on how to take care of your new Essix retainer:

How to take care of your retainer

- 1. Only remove your retainers to brush or to eat.
- 2. Store your retainers in the included case. **Never** put them directly in your pocket, as *they will be crushed*, and **do not** wrap them in a napkin, as *you will lose them*.
- 3. Keep them away from pets who may want to chew on them
- 4. Clean your retainer with a toothbrush and toothpaste to eliminate plaque, stains, and odors.
- 5. Keep out of direct sunlight.
- 6. The retainers are temperature sensitive, they can melt if exposed to high temperatures.
- 7. Avoid contact with hot or boiling water, the retainers can melt.

About your Essix retainer

Following orthodontic treatment, teeth may try to return to their original position. This is called a *relapse*. A retainer is usually prescribed to prevent the teeth from shifting after braces are taken off. In some cases, a retainer can also make minor orthodontic corrections.

An ESSIX retainer is a clear, removable retainer made from a dental-grade thermoset plastic. They are custom-made to fit each patient.

Although your braces are off, you will still need to return a few more times to make sure that the retainers are doing their job and that they are being worn correctly. *Make sure to bring your retainers to every appointment!* **If you lose or break your retainer, call us as soon as possible** so that you don't lose your smile!
